The Family Partnership Model is widely used in children's centres and early years, community health, social care, schools, child development services, and child and adolescent mental health services.

The Family Partnership Model improves child development, childhood emotional and behavioural difficulties, parent-child interaction, and the wellbeing of parents and families.

The Family Partnership Model brings together key helping qualities, skills and methods into a straightforward framework that builds on family strengths and expertise to enable children and families to change and achieve the very best.
